Minutes of Special Meeting held October 4, 2024

The Bonneville County Fire Protection District No. 1 (“Fire District”) held a special meeting of Commissioners on Friday, the 4th day of October, 2024 at the offices of Nelson Hall Parry Tucker, PLLC, at 490 Memorial Drive, Suite 200, Idaho Falls, Idaho 83402 convening at 12:00 p.m.

The following were present:

Commissioners Ralph Isom, Derik Nielsen, Dana Kirkham, David Long, and Tyler Gebbs were present. District Operations Officer Dick Fowler, Chief Stacy Hyde, and Attorney Abigail French were also present.

Notice of the time, place and purpose was posted at premises of 490 Memorial Drive, Idaho Falls, Idaho, as well as the Fire District website. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes.


